- 56 individual joint undergraduate faculty/student research projects were funded for a total of \$40,000. These projects involved 43 faculty members, 102 students and 17 programs within the three colleges.

- Support for a visiting professor from the School of Computing and Mathematics, University of Western Sydney, to participate in Algebra research project in the Department of Mathematics

- Attendance at the SIFE (Students in Free Enterprise) National Competition, RISE (Redefining Investment Strategy Education) Competition, and the SHRM (Society of Human Resource Management) competition for 18 College of Business students and 3 faculty members
- Attendance at the Mid Atlantic Regional Chapter - American College of Sports Medicine Conference for 4 College of Education and Human Services, Exercise Science, students
- Attendance at the United Nations Conference for students in the Department of Social Work and Gerontology

Speakers/Cultural Events

- Trip to the Holocaust Museum for students in the Social Work Department
- Keynote speaker from The Professional Edge for the Marketing Club Etiquette Dinner

Purchase of Scientific Equipment

- Purchase of software and equipment for a senior research project in the Computer Science Department
- Purchase of computer terminals for the Computer Science Department
- Purchase of photography studio supplies for the Communication/Journalism Department

Guest Artists/Presentations

- Guest musicians for the three Festival Chamber Orchestra concerts
- Presentations by three artists in support of their exhibits in the Kauffman Gallery
