



FUNDING YOUR ENDOWMENT

Thank you for your interest in investing in the future of Shippensburg University's students, faculty, and programs.

An outright gift to initiate a scholarship or other endowment can be made in full or budgeted over five years. Additional contributions may be made to the principal at any time. Please note, the first awarding of your fund will occur after the principal in the endowment has reached your chosen endowment level in a given year and earned income has accumulated for at least one year from the date of your gift. You may also combine outright gifts with planned gifts,

or your gift may fund an endowment through a planned gift alone. However, establishing your endowment with an outright gift allows you to see your gift at work for the benefit of Shippensburg University.

Are you interested in seeing the impact of your endowment today? The SU Foundation offers an early activation option. Early activation means that a student, program, or other designated recipient will receive the amount shown for the Fall semester of the next academic year.

\$50,000+ Named Endowed Scholarship Fund

- Academic, athletic, or textbook scholarship
- Four-year, upper division, transfer, or graduate scholarship
- Option to specify GPA (2.8 minimum)
- Optional Criteria
 - › choose a college, school, or program, or major
 - › choose a county or school district in Pennsylvania
 - › designate the scholarship as needs-based or for underrepresented populations.

\$25,000 Named Endowed Scholarship Fund

- Academic, athletic, or textbook scholarship
- Four-year, upper division, transfer or graduate scholarship
- Recipient will have a GPA of 2.8 or above
- Optional Criteria: choose a college, school, or program and may designate the scholarship as needs-based.
